The programme is unique as it involves lectures from experts and hands on simulation experience, immersing in the real time scenarios and thus to thoroughly learn from the experience.


The programme has a combination of common clinical scenarios that are faced by clinicians on a regular basis. It also has some rare high risk events and provide a multidisciplinary experience.

# Obstetric Emergency Simulation

PERINATCON – 2024 Obstetric emergency Simulation will focus primarily on the obstetric scenarios, providing expert guidance and leadership in managing these critical situations. Additionally, simulation will play a pivotal role in the combined sessions, working alongside the neonatal team to ensure a cohesive and effective learning experience.

## Learning objectives :

- Learn to manage eclamptic seizures through prompt administration of anticonvulsants and supportive care, ensuring maternal and fetal safety.
- Learn early recognition and management of ectopic pregnancy to prevent life-threatening complications.
- Learn immediate interventions to relieve cord compression and optimise fetal oxygenation until delivery including management of 3rd stage of Labour
- Learn protocols for managing postpartum haemorrhage, including pharmacological options to control bleeding and management of major haemorrhage as a team.
- Practise the management of shoulder dystocia, focusing on prompt and effective manoeuvres to safely deliver the baby while minimising maternal and neonatal complications.
- Learn prompt recognition and treatment of maternal sepsis, focusing on stabilising the mother with awareness of growing foetus.
- Learn the challenges of a rapid delivery and critical steps of a caesarean section, focusing on rapid decision-making and coordination between the obstetric and neonatal teams to optimise outcomes for both mother and baby.
- Learn skills to performing instrumental deliveries in situations where the baby is unwell.
